

# SPCS DRIVING/RIDING PERMISSION

Dear Parents,

In the past, there has been a problem with unlicensed students driving on the SPCS campus. Because this is illegal and opens the school to liability problems, it is against our rules. Students driving illegally on the SPCS campus will lose their driving privileges (after they get their license) for the remainder of that school year. Please note that students with permits or restricted licenses are expected to comply with the legal restrictions of the state under which they are licensed. Licensed student drivers need parental permission to drive other students in their cars.

**We also require that the office have on file a copy of your student's license and insurance card.** Please check all that apply.
